The 2010 Operating Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to remove and replace the existing security culvert and walkway. The project also includes installation of new security grills and feecing along with stream bank protection.

The objective of this contract is to maintain the integrity of the Airport's perimeter security fencing.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the Airport meets standards for facility security, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This project will provide an environmental benefit by improving stream bank protection thus eliminating erosion.

If this resolution is not approved, the Airport's security perimeter could potentially be breached.

The department will utilize Primavera Software Management tools to track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Payment for this entire contract will be made from the Airport Special Revenue Fund, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.

RESOLVED, that adequate and sufficient security for the faithful performance of this contract shall be deemed to be receipt of a performance and payment bond in an amount equal to 100% of the total contract amount, and in a form approved by the County Attorney. The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Chapter 308 of the Laws of the County of Westchester, the policy of the County is to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
