Towns of Mount Pleasant and Greenburgh, New York
Contractor: PCI Industries Corp.
Amount: \$247,341.00

On October 13, 2010, eight (08) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 08-512 for Resurfacing and Drainage Improvements, Virginia Road (C.R. 35 & 51) from Hillside Avenue to the Bronx River Parkway, A Distance of 0.36 Miles, Towns of Mount Pleasant and Greenburgh, New York.

The town line between Greenburgh and Mount Pleasant runs down the center of Virginia Road. The County is responsible only for the portion of Virginia Road within the Town of Mount Pleasant. The Town of Greenburgh is responsible for the portion within its municipal limits. In order to complete the improvements to Virginia Road, the Town of Greenburgh, concurrently with the County's award of Contract No. 08-512, will award their share of the project.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that PCI Industries Corp. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$247,341.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that PCI Industries Corp.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to replace substandard areas of asphalt paving, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that Virginia Road meets current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs.

The project will provide an environmental benefit by eliminating flooding conditions due to damaged drainage structures.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 08-512 be awarded to PCI Industries Corp. in the amount of \$247,341.00.
