SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing an Agreement between the County of Westchester and the

City of Peekskill for a Monument Park Improvement Project in the City of Peekskill

The attached resolution authorizes the County of Westchester to enterinto an agreement with the City of Peekskill to provide a grant from the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). The grant will be used for a Monument Park Improvement Project in the City of Peekskill. The term of the agreement is March 15, 2011 to December 31, 2011 and the amount of the grant is \$95,000.00, to be paid pursuant to an approved budget.

The City of Peekskill plans to implement an improvement project in Monument Park in the City of Peekskill. The project will include, but is not limited to, removal and installation of brick pavement, installation of brick piers, installation of benches and uplight.

The agreement will serve the public purpose of public safety and promoting fiscal responsibility.

The goal and objective of the agreement is to ensure the public safety of this low/moderate income neighborhood in the City of Peekskill. The project exhibits fiscal responsibility by securing non-County taxpayer resources. The project will be monitored by the Department of Planning staff during their bimonthly site visits during construction to ensure all contractual requirements are met.

This procurement is in compliance with the County of Westchester Procurement Policy Procedures, pursuant to Section 3(a)xvi, which states that contracts with recipients for disbursement of grants or loans under the Community Development Block Grant Program are exempt.

Act # 11,2010, adopted March 15, 2010, by the Westchester County Board of Legislators, authorized the County to file an FY 2009-2013 Consolidated Plan application consisting of an Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2010 as an Urban County to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Act # 152-2005 authorized the County to enter into cooperation agreements with forty (40) municipalities participating in the program as the first step in qualifying these municipalities to receive these funds during Fiscal Year 2010.

On April 29, 2010, the Board of Acquisition and Contract approved a resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the thirty-fifth year grant totaling \$8,473,589.00 from HUD. The allocation for the

Community Development Block Grant Program is \$6,378,239.00. This project will be funded from the thirty-fifth year CDBG allocation.

Pursuant to Act No. 11-2010, prior to disbursement of any grant funds received by the County in connection herewith, any recipient must commit in writing to affirmatively further fair housing ("AFFH") within its borders. Pursuant thereto, such recipient shall agree to certify in writing to the County that it is in compliance with the following terms and conditions, as appropriate, in connection with its commitment Jer Rer Co. Apment of Jersey Active From & Conference 1 - 12-20-2010 - Johnsey William & Conference 1 - 12-20-2010 to AFFH, in that it will actively further implementation of the Settlement Agreement and Order in United States of America ex.rel. Anti-Discrimination Center of Metro New York, Inc. v. Westchester County, NY through recipient's land use regulations and other affirmative measures to assist development of affordable housing, under such terms and conditions as approved by the County Attorney.

I recommend approval of this agreement.

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Peekskill, through the Community Development Block Grant Program, in the amount of \$95,000.00, pursuant to an approved budget, for a term beginning March 15, 2011 and ending December 31, 2011, for the Monument Park Improvement Project in the City of Peekskill. The project will include, but is not limited to, removal and installation of brick pavement, installation of brick piers, installation of benches and uplight, and be it further
