On December 15, 2010, eight (08) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 09-512 for Household Materials Recovery Facility, Valhalla Campus, Valhalla, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Arben Group LLC submitted the low bid in the amount of \$2,488,773.00, and has proposed the utilization of the following subcontractors: Duncan Industries Corp. (HVAC Work), 121 Lafayette Avenue, North White Plains, New York 10603; RLJ Electric Corp. (Electrical Work), 860 Washington Street, Peekskill, New York 10566; and Mengler Mechanical Inc. (Plumbing Work), 1689 Route 22, Brewster, New York 10509.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Arben Group LLC:

The objective of this contract is to construct a centralized facility for the disposal and processing of all household waste not accepted by local carters.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
