SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing an Amendment to the Agreement between the County of Westchester and The Town of Greenburgh for a Sidewalk Project on Tarrytown Road in the Town of Greenburgh, in order to Change the Expiration Date

On January 28, 2010, your Honorable Board approved a resolution to enter into an agreement with the Town of Greenburgh for a "Sidewalks – A Safety Solution for Tarrytown Road" project for the installation of sidewalks on Tarrytown Road (Route 119) near the Crossroads Shopping Center. The amount of the grant was \$45,000.00, from the Community Development Block Grant Program.

The attached resolution authorizes the County of Westchester to amend the agreement with the Town of Greenburgh for the construction of sidewalks and guide rails near the Crossroads Shopping Center in the Town of Greenburgh. This amendment will change the expiration date from January 31, 2011, to January 31, 2012. All other terms and conditions of the agreement will remain the same.

The Town of Greenburgh is requesting an extension to the agreement as additional time is needed to secure the required New York State Department of Transportation permits and the engineering of necessary pedestrian walk signals at the project site.

The agreement will serve the public purpose of public safety and fiscal responsibility. The goal and objective of the agreement is to ensure the safety of the public by constructing sidewalks and guide rails to allow pedestrians a safe walkway in the Town of Greenburgh. The project also exhibits fiscal responsibility by securing non-County taxpayer resources. The program will be monitored by the Department of Planning staff, who will make monthly site visits during construction to ensure all contractual requirements are met.

I recommend approval of this amendment.
