Re: Resolution to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy an Agreement with My Sisters' Place, Inc., ("MSP") pursuant to which MSP shall provide case coordination for MSP counselors and attorneys, technical assistance to law enforcement and service providers and provide training to law enforcement, social service providers and other community based agencies to assist victims of human trafficking for the period of September 1, 2010 to May 31, 2011, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00, pursuant to Section 3(a)xxi of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures

Authority is hereby requested from your Honorable Board, to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy an agreement with My Sisters' Place, Inc., ("MSP") pursuant to which MSP shall provide case coordination for MSP counselors and attorneys, technical assistance to law enforcement and service providers and provide training to law enforcement, social service providers and other community based agencies to assist victims of human trafficking for the period of September 1, 2010 to May 31, 2011, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00, payable upon execution.

Ordinarily, under Section 6 of the Procurement Policy, the County is required to issue a Request For Proposals for such services. It is proposed that compliance with the Procurement Policy would not be in the best interests of the County with respect to this procurement because MSP is a non-profit organization that has been dedicated to shelter, counseling, legal and mentoring services to victims of human trafficking for residents of our region for more than ten (10) years and has drawn on strong existing community partnerships to provide referrals for other necessary services. In 2007, MSP was chosen by the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) to serve as the human trafficking services provider for New York State's Lower Hudson Valley region. In the last two (2) years, MSP has served over twenty (20) victims of sex and/or labor trafficking—men, women and children.

Based on the above, it is respectfully submitted that MSP is uniquely qualified to provide this service to the County and that an exemption to compliance with the procedures of the Procurement Policy be granted by your Honorable Board in accordance with section 3(a)xxi of said Policy.
