RE: Authorization to enter into Contract with the New York State Department of Health to accept continued funding for the Drinking Water Program Local Assistance Funding Enhancement Grant as follows:

Term: 4/1/11 - 3/31/12
Amount: Not to Exceed \$221,325

The Westchester County Department of Health ("WCDH") seeks authorization to enter into contract with the New York State Department of Health ("NYSDOH") to accept continued funding for the Drinking Water Program Local Assistance Funding Enhancement grant, pursuant to an approved budget, for the period 4/1/11 – 3/31/12, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$221,325.

The public purpose of this contract is to promote the public health and welfare of County residents by performing regulatory oversight and issuance of operating permits for all impacted public water supplies.

The goal of this program is to enhance the County's Drinking Water Enhancement program through elimination of known public health hazards, investigation of potential waterborne disease outbreaks attributable to drinking water supplies and enforcement of the federal ground water rule.

Continuation of the Drinking Water Enhancement program ensures that drinking water supplies receive annual operating permits from the WCDH, provided that the water supplies comply with both Part 5 of the New York State Sanitary Code and Chapter 873 Article VIII of the Westchester County Sanitary Code. The WCDH is responsible for one hundred (100) community water supplies and one hundred ninety (190) non-community and non-transient community water supplies.

This program is monitored by conducting water sample testing for lead, copper and coliform levels, by providing optimum corrosion control treatment when required, and submission of annual water quality reports, an emergency response and vulnerability assessment and a cross connection plan to the NYSDOH.

Approval of the attached resolution is respectfully requested.
