The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to repair ruptured steam pipes and damaged manholes on the Dana Road steam distribution line.

The objective of this contract is to repair the damaged portions of the steam distribution line that deliver steam for the heating of the County's Public Health Lab.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the Public Health Lab's heating system will remain operational.

The project will provide an energy savings by eliminating steam leaks, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Fiscal Responsibility (FR).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
