The 2011 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for demolition and replacement of the existing footbridge, reconstruction of the concrete spillway and apron, stabilization of river banks, and rehabilitation of drain control valves, structures and gates. The project also includes all associated site work.

The objective of this contract is to upgrade substandard structural components of the Pocantico Lake Dam, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the Pocantico Lake Dam meets current codes and standards as well as meeting the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation's Order on Consent for this structure.

The project will provide an environmental benefit by improving storm water control thus eliminating erosion and flooding conditions.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
