Re: Authority for the County of Westchester to renew an agreement with the Putnam/Northern Westchester Board of Cooperative Educational Services for co-sponsorship of adult and continuing education programs for the period September 1, 2011 through August 31, 2012

By resolution approved on September 24, 2009 (the "September 24th Resolution"), your Board authorized the County acting by and through the Westchester Community College (the "College") to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement") with the Putnam/Northern Westchester Board of Cooperative Educational Services (the "Northern BOCES") whereby the College and Northern BOCES would develop and implement co-sponsorship of adult and continuing education programs to be offered to the general public using the combined resources, talents, services and facilities of each party. The Agreement provides that the College furnish administrative and financial support and that Northern BOCES furnish registration services, course announcements, teaching and other personnel together with classroom space, tuition collection and deposit services and on-site management services for the co-sponsored programs. The term of the Agreement is September 1, 2009 through August 31, 2010 with the County having the sole option to renew the Agreement for up to four (4) additional one (1) year periods.

Authority is requested for the County to renew the Agreement for the second renewal period September 1, 2011 through August 31, 2012 in an amount not to exceed Four

Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty- Five Dollars (\$486,825), pursuant to an approved budget.

The College has statutory authority to enter into this Agreement Pursuant to New York State Education Law section 6306(7), which states “Subject to the approval of the local sponsor . . . the board of trustees of each community college may enter into any contract or agreement deemed necessary or appropriate for the effective operation of the college...” Accordingly, approval of the Board of Legislators under GML Section 119-o is not required.

The Agreement is exempt from the procurement policy pursuant to Section 3(a)(iii) thereof.

Except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement shall remain unchanged.

This contract will enable the College to continue its mission of providing life long learning for the residents of Westchester County. The contract performance is monitored by the College Office of Institutional Research to ensure that contractual obligations are met by Northern BOCES.

Accordingly, I recommend adoption of the attached resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the President of Westchester Community College, be it hereby:

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester be and hereby is authorized to renew an Agreement with the Putnam/Northern Westchester BOCES for the co-sponsorship of adult and continuing education programs, commencing September 1, 2011 and terminating August 31, 2012, in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$486,825), to be paid quarterly pursuant to an approved budget; and be it further

RESOLVED, that except as specifically amended hereby, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain the same; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee be and hereby is authorized and empowered to execute any and all instruments and to take all action necessary to implement the purposes hereof.
