The 2012 Operating Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to perform testing and treatment services at various County buildings and facilities located throughout Westchester County. This contract is for a term of three (3) years with one (1) two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County.

The objective of this contract is to provide periodic testing and chemical treatment of the water in all heating and air conditioning equipment.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by preventing bacterial growth and corrosion of the systems using environmentally friendly chemicals and will promote fiscal responsibility by reducing the County's annual maintenance costs.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

Payment for a portion of this contract will be made from the Airport Special Revenue Fund, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.
