SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing a second amendment to the agreement between the County of Westchester and the Town of Greenburgh for a sidewalk project on Tarrytown Road, in order to change the expiration date

On January 28, 2010, your Honorable Board approved a resolution to authorize the County to enter into an agreement with the Town of Greenburgh for a "Sidewalks – A Safety Solution for Tarrytown Road" project for the installation of sidewalks on Tarrytown Road (Route 119) near the Crossroads Shopping Center. The term of the agreement is February 1, 2010 to January 31, 2011. The amount of the grant is \$45,000.00, from the Community Development Block Grant Program.

On February 10, 2011, your Honorable Board approved a resolution to amend the above referenced agreement to change the expiration date from January 31, 2011, to January 31, 2012.

The attached resolution authorizes the County to amend the agreement with the Town to change the expiration date from January 31, 2012 to December 31, 2012. All other terms and conditions of the agreement will remain the same.

The Town is requesting an extension as the project had to be redesigned to include pedestrian signals and loop detectors to meet the requirements of the New York State Department of Transportation. There were also unforeseen issues with Con Ed gas utilities in the roadway that caused additional delays.

The goal and objective of the original agreement is to ensure the safety of the public by constructing sidewalks and guide rails to allow pedestrians a safe walkway in the Town of Greenburgh. The program will be monitored by Department of Planning staff, who will make monthly site visits during construction to ensure all contractual requirements are met.
