The 2012 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to construct pedestrian pads and associated sidewalks. Additional work includes replacement of curbing, installation of handicapped curb cuts and signage.

The objective of this contract is to upgrade substandard conditions at bus stop locations along Central Park Avenue in the Cities of White Plains and Yonkers and the Town of Greenburgh, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that bus stop locations along Central Park Avenue in the Cities of White Plains and Yonkers and the Town of Greenburgh meet current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs. There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Payment for a portion of this contract will be made from Federal Transit Administration Funds, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.
