On January 11, 2012, four (04) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 11-221 for Guide Railing Replacement, Bronx River Parkway and Various County Roadways, Westchester County, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Central Industries, Inc. **(WBE)** submitted the low bid in the amount of \$383,445.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Central Industries, Inc. **(WBE)**:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

 Non-Recurring Budget
 Operating Budget
 Other (6N Insurance Account)

The objective of this contract is to replace damaged railings and posts.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by meeting American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO) standards for highway safety. There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 11-221 be awarded to Central Industries, Inc. **(WBE)** in the amount of \$383,445.00, subject to appropriations.

Payment for this contract will be made from a special account. The funds have been collected from automobile insurance companies by the Office of Risk Management, thus there will be no impact on the County tax levy.

RESOLUTION

CONTRACT NO. 11-221

Upon communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it

RESOLVED, that Contract No. 11-221 for Guide Railing Replacement, Bronx River Parkway and Various County Roadways, Westchester County, New York be and is hereby awarded to the low bidder, Central Industries, Inc. (**WBE**), 142 Gailmore Drive, Yonkers, New York 10710, in the amount of \$383,445.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this contract is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
