RE: Authority to enter into a license agreement with Powell Catering Services, Inc.,

58 Halstead Avenue, Harrison, NY 10528 for the operation of the food and refreshment concession at Saxon Woods Park, White Plains, New York, for the

period April 15, 2012 through December 31, 2014

On May 9, 2002, the Board of Acquisition and Contract granted authority for the County of Westchester to enter into a license agreement with Powell Catering Services, Inc. for the period June 1, 2002 through December 31, 2006, with the sole option of the County to extend the agreement for a period of five years. The Board of Acquisition and Contract, on April 13, 2007, granted authority to extend the agreement from January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2011.

Authority is hereby requested for the County of Westchester, acting by and through the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation, to enter into a license agreement with Powell Catering Services, Inc., 58 Halstead Avenue, Harrison, NY 10528 for the operation of the food and refreshment concession at Saxon Woods Park, White Plains, New York for the period of April 15, 2012 through December 31, 2014.

For the privilege of operating the food and refreshment concession, Powell Catering Services, Inc. shall pay to the County an annual license fee as follows:

The greater of \$35,000 or .60 per bathing ticket sold in 2012 The greater of \$35,000 or .61 per bathing ticket sold in 2013 The greater of \$35,000 or .61 per bathing ticket sold in 2014.

The license fee, which is based on the number of bathing tickets sold, will include all bathing tickets sold to the general public and 50% of the bathing tickets sold to day camps.

In addition to the above license fees, Powell Catering Services, Inc. shall complete repairs to the facility for a total estimated value of \$2,200 as listed on the attached schedule. All repairs will be completed no later than June 20, 2012. Powell Catering Services, Inc. will also furnish and install a removable ice cream kiosk, at its sole expense, to better serve patrons on the pool deck and reduce lines.

Although licenses are exempt from the County's Procurement Policy pursuant to section 3(b) therein, a Request for Proposals was developed and four proposals were received. After considering the proposals it was recommended that the miniature golf concession and food and beverage concession be combined. At the present time there is an overlap between the separate concessions concerning events and vending. Both concessions are operated by the same concessionaire. Having separate concession operators could lead to coordination difficulties which would not be beneficial to the overall operation of the pool. The miniature golf concession does not expire until December 31, 2014. Therefore, it was recommended to enter into a license for three seasons so that the expiration dates of the two concessions will coincide and an RFP can be developed covering both operations commencing with the 2015 season.

The goal of this agreement is to provide revenue for the County and food and beverage service for patrons at Saxon Woods Park. The objective of this agreement will be tracked and monitored by observations and interactions with staff and site visits.

This agreement is exempt from the Westchester County procurement policy pursuant to Section 3(b), thereof.

Accordingly, approval of the attached resolution by your Honorable Board is most respectfully requested.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester is hereby authorized to enter into a license agreement with Powell Catering Services, Inc., 58 Halstead Avenue, Harrison, NY 10528 for the operation of the food and refreshment concession at Saxon Woods Park, White Plains, New York, for the period April 15, 2012 through December 31, 2014; and be it further

RESOLVED, that for the privilege of operating the food and refreshment concession, Powell Catering Services, Inc., shall pay to the County an annual license fee as follows:

The greater of \$35,000 or .60 per bathing ticket sold in 2012 The greater of \$35,000 or .61 per bathing ticket sold in 2013 The greater of \$35,000 or .61 per bathing ticket sold in 2014; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the license fee, which is based on the number of bathing tickets sold, will include all bathing tickets sold to the general public and 50% of the bathing tickets sold to day camps; and be it further

RESOLVED, that Powell Catering Services, Inc., shall complete capital improvements valued at \$2,200 listed on the attached schedule; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute all instruments necessary to implement this Resolution.
