RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER TO 1) ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES TO ACCEPT A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$105,394 IN FEDERAL FUNDS AND TO CONTRIBUTE \$242,009 IN COUNTY MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE TO OPERATE THE SEXUAL ASSAULT VICTIMS AND ELDERLY SERVICES (SAVES) PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2011 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2012; AND 2) ENTER INTO A SUB-AWARDEE AGREEMENT WITH THE WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM INC. (VICTIMS ASSISTANCE SERVICES) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,000, PURSUANT TO AN APPROVED BUDGET, TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES OF AN ELDER ABUSE SPECIALIST, FOR THE SAME PERIOD

Authority is sought for the County of Westchester to 1) enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services ("NYSDCJS") to accept a grant in the amount of \$105,394 in Federal funds and contribute \$242,009 in County matching funds to operate the Sexual Assault Victims and Elderly Services ("SAVES") program, for the period October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012; and 2) enter into a sub-awardee agreement with the Westchester Community Opportunity Program, Inc. (Victims Assistance Services) ("WestCOP") in the amount of \$16,000, pursuant to an approved budget, to provide the services of an Elder Abuse Specialist, for the same period. The reason the resolution is being submitted at such a late date is that the approval from New York State was just received.

The SAVES Program is funded with Federal dollars provided by the Federal Violence Against Women Act. The District Attorney will receive \$105,394 in federal funds and enter into a sub-awardee agreement with WestCOP which will receive \$16,000 in Federal funds. The County will also contribute \$242,009 in County matching funds.

The SAVES program promotes the general welfare and public safety of the citizens of the Westchester County by helping to reduce sexual and physical violence against elderly women and enhance the vertical prosecution of sexual and physical elder assault cases, as well as the delivery of services to women victims of sexual violence. The goals and objectives of these agreements are to help support the salary and fringe of two positions in the District Attorney's Office and an Elder Abuse Specialist at WestCOP. The goals and objectives of the SAVES program will be monitored by the District Attorney's Office and quarterly progress reports will be submitted to DCJS for their review and approval

The agreement to accept a grant from NYSDCJS does not constitute a procurement and as such is not subject to the County Procurement Policy. The agreement with WestCOP is exempt from the Procurement Policy pursuant to section 3(a)xii thereof which exempts "procurements which involve the expenditure of federal or state assistance where and to the extent that federal or state law, rules or regulations conflict with the provisions of the Policy." It should be noted that DCJS considers WestCOP to be a sub-awardee, not a consultant. DCJS considered the sub-awardee to be appropriate at the time of application (October 3, 2011) and approved for sole source.

RESOLUTION

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester is authorized to 1) enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services to accept a grant in the amount of \$105,394 in Federal funds and contribute \$242,009 in County matching funds for the District Attorney to operate the Sexual Assault Victims and Elderly Services (SAVES) Program for the period October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012; and 2) enter into a sub-awardee agreement with the Westchester Community Opportunity Program, Inc. (Victims Assistance Services) in the amount of \$16,000, pursuant to an approved budget, to provide the services of an Elder Abuse Specialist, for the same period; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the District Attorney or her duly authorized designee be and hereby is authorized and empowered to enter into this agreement for the County of Westchester.
