On August 1, 2012, one (1) bid was received and opened for Contract No. 12-219 for Maintenance of IQ/PowerNet System, Valhalla Campus, Valhalla, New York.

One (1) contractor submitted a bid for this project. The project was advertised on the Hudson Valley Municipal Purchasing Group ("HVM") website, in addition to the Journal News (Southern Edition), and was viewed by four (4) entities on the HVM website. In addition, e-mails were sent to those four (4) entities and to an additional three (3) suppliers and contractors.

The bid was reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Advanced Testing Systems, Inc. submitted the sole bid in the amount of \$150,900.00.

The sole bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Advanced Testing Systems, Inc.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

- Capital Budget
 Non-Recurring Budget
 Operating Budget

The objective of this contract is to provide for the continued operation of the IQ/PowerNet system.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring the continued reliability of the IQ/PowerNet system along with reducing the County's annual maintenance costs, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Fiscal Responsibility (FR).

This project will provide a reduction in energy usage by eliminating the need for employees to manually read electrical meters throughout the Valhalla Campus.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

This contract is for a term of three (3) years with one two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 12-219 be awarded to Advanced Testing Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$150,900.00, subject to appropriations.

RESOLUTION

CONTRACT NO. 12-219

Upon communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it

RESOLVED, that Contract No. 12-219 for Maintenance of IQ/PowerNet System, Valhalla Campus, Valhalla, New York be and is hereby awarded to the sole bidder, Advanced Testing Systems, Inc., 15 Trowbridge Drive, Bethel, Connecticut 06801, in the amount of \$150,900.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that as set forth in the Contract No. 12-219 bid specifications, this contract is for a term of three (3) years with one two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this contract is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
