The 2012 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the replacement of scum removal facilities for the primary and final settling tanks and includes the demolition of existing units and installation of new skimmer piping and manual handwheel operators.

The objective of this contract is to allow the Department of Environmental Facilities to maintain its treatment plant systems and to ensure continuous and reliable processing of wastewater.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring continued uninterrupted operation of the plant's wastewater treatment systems. This project will enable the Department of Environmental Facilities to carry out its basic mission to provide wastewater treatment and maintain satisfactory water quality, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
