On May 2, 2012, fourteen (14) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 11-549 for Bus Stop Improvements, Various Locations, Cities of White Plains and Yonkers and Town of Greenburgh, New York. The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Paladino Concrete Creations Corp. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$200,345.00.

Paladino Concrete Creations Corp.'s bid of \$200,345.00 was subsequently negotiated down to \$184,999.95 in order to fall within the Federal Transit Administration's grant amount for this project. In accordance with the law, the negotiated amount does not decrease in any way the scope of work set forth in the bid specification and makes no concessions whatsoever to the bidder. The negotiations were solely for the purpose of obtaining price concessions.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Paladino Concrete Creations Corp.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to upgrade substandard conditions at bus stop locations along Central Park Avenue in the Cities of White Plains and Yonkers and the Town of Greenburgh, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that bus stop locations along Central Park Avenue in the Cities of White Plains and Yonkers and the Town of Greenburgh meet current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs. There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 11-549 be awarded to Paladino Concrete Creations Corp. in the amount of \$184,999.95.

Payment for a portion of this contract will be made from Federal Transit Administration Funds, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.
