PROJECTS FUNDS (Grant Agreement No. K007045)

Authority is requested to enter into an agreement with the New York State Department of Transportation for the receipt of \$1,676,017.00 in Mass Transportation capital projects funds. The revenue from the New York State grant will be credited to the following projects:

The local appropriation required to match funds credited to the operating budget or trust accounts is available within the current operating budget through in-kind expenses charged to Bus Operating Assistance 101-44-2100-4924 and Advance to Grants 101-44-1000-4912.

The local appropriation required to match funds credited to the capital budget or capital accounts is available in the approved 2012 capital budget for the Department of Public Works and Transportation.

Acceptance of these grants will be of direct financial benefit to the County by reducing the cost to the County for the various projects by the full amount of the grant. The grant will be monitored by the County Department of Public Works and Transportation to insure the funds are utilized in accordance with the grant agreement. The acceptance of these grant funds will benefit the public by insuring continued efficient and reliable bus transit service.
