The 2012 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to install new underground conduit and electric feeder cables along with new light post foundations, light posts, ballasts and light fixtures. The project also includes the installation of a new electrical service building.

The objective of this contract is to replace the electrical distribution and lighting systems that serve the Kensico Dam Plaza.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by providing upgraded electrical supply and lighting systems that meet current codes and standards, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

The project will include the installation of new energy saving light fixtures and ballasts thereby reducing overall energy usage.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
