Re: Authority to enter into affiliation agreements with (i) Atria on the Hudson; (ii) Kendal on Hudson; (iii) Four Winds Hospital; (iv) The Osborn; (v) Putnam Hospital Center; and (vi) St. Barnabas Hospital for laboratory/clinical education and instruction.

Westchester Community College (the "College"), through its Division of Natural & Health Sciences, offers a number of programs in the healthcare field. The College offers supervised laboratory/clinical education and instruction for matriculated Westchester Community College students who are pursuing a degree or certificate in conjunction with various organizations. Attached is a resolution that would authorize the College to enter into agreements with the following organizations for the following specified programs and terms:

1. Atria on the Hudson - Certified Nursing Assistant Program (September 1, 2012 – December 31, 2016)
2. Kendal on Hudson - Certified Nursing Assistant Program (October 1, 2012 – December 31, 2016)
3. Four Winds Hospital - Dietetic Technician Program (January 1, 2013 – December 31, 2017)
4. The Osborn - Nursing Program (January 1, 2013 – December 31, 2017)
5. Putnam Hospital Center - Surgical Technology and Central Sterile Programs (January 1, 2013 – December 31, 2017)
6. St. Barnabas Hospital - Surgical Technology Program (October 1, 2012 – December 31, 2016)

There will be no cost to the College, but the parties will cross indemnify each other for their respective negligence.

I believe that it is in the best interest of the College to provide clinical education and instruction programs; and I therefore, recommend that you act favorably on the annexed proposed resolution.
