The 2012 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the rehabilitation of the Warburton Avenue Bridge from Washington Avenue to Main Street. Work includes removal and replacement of the existing concrete deck, asphalt wearing surface, stone curbing and sidewalks along with installation of steel bridge railing with chain link fence. Work also includes structural steel repairs, installation of new bridge bearings, painting of the steel structure and repair to the revetment block and other areas of the end abutment walls.

The objective of this contract is to repair substandard structural elements of the Warburton Avenue Bridge, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the Warburton Avenue Bridge meets current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs. There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
