RE: Emergency hauling and disposal of liquid sludge from various Wastewater Treatment Plants, Westchester County
Contractor: Naugatuck Environmental Technologies LLC
Amount: \$64,125.00

In accordance with the policies of the County Executive regarding emergency contracts, Your Honorable Board was notified by a memorandum on October 30, 2012 for an emergency condition of the hauling and disposal of liquid sludge from Peekskill, Port Chester, Ossining and New Rochelle wastewater treatment plants. The Department's incumbent contractor, Spectraserv was unable to perform the necessary work for hauling and disposal of liquid sludge, and thus it was necessary to select an emergency contractor Naugatuck Environmental Technologies LLC ("Naugatuck") to perform the work.

Naugatuck Environmental Technologies LLC completed the job of hauling and disposal of liquid sludge from New Rochelle, Ossining, Peekskill and Port Chester wastewater treatment plants in the not-to-exceed amount of \$64,125.00 for a term October 30, 2012 through November 08, 2012. In the October 30th memorandum, your Honorable Board was advised that once the hauling was completed, a Resolution requesting approval of final cost would be presented. The actual amount of liquid sludge required to be hauled and disposed of under this emergency contract was 585,000 gallons. The total cost of removal of this liquid sludge was \$64,125.00.

The objective of this contract is to reimburse the Contractor for services provided under an emergency situation. This Contract is deemed to fulfill a public purpose as the services provided under this Contract protect the building and facilities owned by the Department of Environmental Facilities and enables the Department to carry out its basic mission to provide wastewater treatment and maintain satisfactory water quality.

The work is fiscally responsible and ensures the health and safety of Westchester County residents because if this work were not undertaken, critical process equipment could not be operated and wastewater discharge standards may not be met. During the term of the Contract, Department representatives monitored the removal of sludge and the Contractor was responsible to comply with such regulations and that all applicable regulations, safety precautions and codes were adhered to and that a cost effective project was the end project.

Approval is recommended.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Environmental Facilities,

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Environmental Facilities requests approval of a Contract between the County of Westchester and Naugatuck Environmental Technologies LLC., 500 Cherry St, Naugatuck, CT 06770,

WHEREAS, the actual amount of liquid sludge removed for the New Rochelle, Ossining, Peekskill and Port Chester wastewater treatment plants was 585,000 gallons; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the removal and disposal of the liquid sludge was for a total amount of \$64,125.00; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been discussed by the Board; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Emergency hauling and disposal of liquid sludge from various Wastewater treatment plants, Westchester County in the amount of \$64,125.00, is hereby approved and authorized, subject to the adoption of the Operating Budget; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
