SUBJECT: Authority for the County of Westchester to exercise the second option to extend the agreement with Public Consulting Group, Inc. (“PCG”) pursuant to which PCG will provide Social Security eligibility services for Aid to Families with Dependent Children – Foster Care (“AFDC-FC”) cases as well as for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families and Safety Net Assistance cases for the County for the term July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 for an amount not-to-exceed \$380,000 to be paid pursuant to an approved budget and subject to appropriation

Pursuant to a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) issued by the Department on April 19, 2011 and a Resolution approved on July 7, 2011, your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with Public Consulting Group, Inc. for the provision of Social Security eligibility services for Aid to Families with Dependent Children–Foster Care (“AFDC-FC”) cases as well as for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families and Safety Net Assistance cases for the County for the term July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 (the “Agreement”) for an amount not to exceed \$350,000 with the County having the option, in its sole discretion, to extend the agreement for up to three (3) additional one (1) year periods. The agreement was subsequently executed.

By a resolution approved on June 21, 2012, your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester, acting by and through its Department of Social Services (“The Department”), to exercise the first option to extend and amend the Agreement with Public Consulting Group, Inc. (“PCG”) for the provision of Social Security eligibility services for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 for an amount not to exceed \$380,000. The first extension was subsequently executed.

Authority is now requested for the County of Westchester, acting by and through its Department of Social Services ("The Department"), to exercise the second option to extend and extend the Agreement with Public Consulting Group, Inc. ("PCG") for the provision of Social Security eligibility services for the period **July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014** for an amount not to exceed **\$380,000** to be paid pursuant to an approved budget and subject to appropriation. The new total not to exceed amount including the original, First Extension and the current Extension shall be \$1,110,000.

The proposed agreement will serve a **public purpose** by providing services to a targeted population which is faced with multiple barriers and is unable to pursue benefits on its own. By definition, the Federal Social Security Supplemental Security Income (SSI) program is targeted towards individuals who are incapable of engaging in substantial gainful employment activity. Particularly, in the case of mental disability, the very nature of the individual's impediment is incongruous with self-advocacy. PCG, under the proposed agreement, will provide necessary assistance to the residents of Westchester County who are eligible for SSI benefits by helping them secure the benefits to which they are entitled.

The **goals and objectives** of the proposed agreement are to provide services in the establishment of eligibility as well as maintenance of SSI benefits for AFDC-FC customers as well as for TANF and SNA customers.

The goals and objectives of the proposed agreement are in the best interests of the County in terms of **fiscal responsibility** as this program will assist DSS customers in securing benefits, thereby leading to case closures and related savings in County resources expended in assisting such individuals.

Additionally, DSS assumes representative payee status for most of the foster care children who are eligible for SSI benefits where the benefits are paid directly to DSS. This program can help defray the annual cost of foster care.

The **performance measurement indicators** will be tracked and monitored through monthly statistics and reports as well as through direct contact with DSS's Program Office. The vendor is only paid when customers are approved for SSI benefits. The Department is able to report that from July 1, 2012 through April 30, 2013, 101 customers became eligible for SSI benefits.

Except as specifically amended hereby, all other terms and conditions of the original agreement as extended shall remain in full force and effect.

Accordingly, authority is requested for the County to exercise its second option to extend the agreement with Public Consulting Group, Inc. for the purpose stated above.

An appropriate resolution is attached herewith for your Honorable Board's approval.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Social Services, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester is hereby authorized to exercise the Second option to extend agreement with Public Consulting Group, Inc. ("PCG") pursuant to which PCG will provide Social Security eligibility services to the County for Aid to Families with Dependent Children – Foster Care ("AFDC-FC") cases as well as for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") and Safety Net Assistance ("SNA") cases for the term July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 for an amount not-to-exceed **\$380,000** and for a new total not to exceed \$1,110,000 including the original Agreement, the first Extension and the proposed Extension; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that except as specifically modified herein, all other terms and conditions of the original agreement as extended shall remain the same; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute all instruments and take all actions reasonably necessary to implement this Resolution.
