Resolution authorizing the Filing of an Application for a State Grant-In-Re:

Aid for a Municipal Waste Reduction and/or Recycling Project and Signing of the

Associated State Contracounder the appropriate laws of New York State

The State of New York, acting pursuant to Chapter 610 of the Laws of 1993, provides for State assistance to local governments for equipment and capital projects related to recycling and waste reduction programs and operations. Under this State Grant-In-Aid program the County will receive a 50 percent reimbursement toward approved and eligible expenses. Applicants must incur all expenses and subsequently request reimbursement. I recommend submission of an application as required by the State for the County's estimated expenses associated with the purchasing of eight (\$39,200) and ten (\$48,100) 30 cubic vard containers in 2012 and 2013, respectively, as well as one (\$5,600) sealed 30 yard roll of container purchased in 2012. These containers are used for the transport of consolidated curbside collected recyclables to the County MRF. While the approval of this Honorable Board is not required by the County Charter to apply for such grants, the State of New York's application procedure requires it.

The public purpose is to receive revenue from New York State that will reimburse the County for 50 percent of the eligible costs for running year-round recycling and waste reduction programs, thus reducing the burden to the taxpayer. The goal and objective for entering into this contract is to continue offering and expanding said programs for the public, at a lower cost to Westchester County residents. DEF staff will continue to monitor Westchester County's recycling programs and in addition will publish the County's annual recycling rate each year. For the past 16 years (since 1997) the County has met or exceeded the state's mandated goal of recycling 40% of the solid waste stream.

I further request authorization to execute the State's grant contract as needed upon receipt. The estimated reimbursement for the above mentioned expenses is \$46,450 (total expense was \$92,900).

## RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Environmental Facilities,

WHEREAS, the State of New York provides financial aid for municipal waste reduction and municipal recycling projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Westchester County Department of Environmental Facilities herein called the County, has examined and duly considered the applicable laws of the State of New York and the County deems it to be in the public interest and benefit to the an application under these laws; and

**WHEREAS,** it is necessary that a Contract by and between THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, herein called the STATE, and the County be executed for such State aid;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESCLVED** by the Westchester County Board of Acquisition and Contract as follows:

**RESOLVED,** that the filing of an application in the form required by the State of New York and in conformity with the applicable laws of the State of New York, including all understanding and assurances contained in said application is hereby authorized; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that the Commissioner of Environmental Facilities is hereby directed and authorized as the official representative of the County of Westchester to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required and to sign the resulting contract, if said application is approved by the state; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that the County of Westchester agrees that it will fund its portion of the cost of said Municipal Reduction and/or Recycling Project costs; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
