**SUBJECT:** Authority to enter into a License Agreement with Mark's Towing, Inc. for Towing and Emergency Repair Services for Zone 2, Westchester County, New York, for a five (5) year period commencing October 1, 2013, for an annual fee payable to the County in the amount of \$56,000.00. (Agreement No. 13-222)

---

The County of Westchester (the "County") issued two (2) separate RFP's requesting proposals from entities interested in providing towing and emergency repair services at County owned properties and facilities and for County vehicles at rates set by the County under a license agreement with the County for a five (5) year period commencing October 1, 2013. The County was broken up into two (2) geographic zones: one (1) for the southerly part of the County (Zone 1), and one (1) for the northerly part of the County (Zone 2). On September 4, 2013, two (2) proposals were received and opened for Zone 2. Upon evaluation of the proposals, it was found that Mark's Towing, Inc. met all of the requirements of the RFP and also offered the highest license fee payable to the County at the rate of \$56,000.00 per year. The experience of Mark's Towing, Inc. has been investigated and found to be satisfactory.

The goal and objective of this license agreement is to provide emergency towing and repair services to the public on County property and for County vehicles as needed in the northerly part of the County (Zone 2). This agreement will serve a public purpose by ensuring the availability of emergency towing and repair services while generating revenue for the County through the license fee paid by the towing company. The Department will track the usage of the license agreement by monitoring the number of service calls provided to vehicle owners. This license agreement has no impact on energy reduction or environmental benefits.

Approval of the attached Resolution is respectfully recommended.

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
