The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Titan Construction Group, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$2,054,300.00, and has proposed the utilization of the following subcontractor: Mezz Electrical Services, Inc. (Electrical Work), 161 Brady Avenue, Hawthorne, New York 10532.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Titan Construction Group, Inc.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.

The objective of this contract is to maintain the structural stability of the South Boardwalk.

There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.
