The 2014 Capital Account contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to plant deciduous trees along the Bronx River Parkway, including post planting care, staking and water retaining devices. The tree planting will be located at Kensico Dam Plaza and at approximately ten different sites along the Bronx River Parkway from Kensico Dam Plaza in the Town of Mount Pleasant to the Sprain Brook Parkway in Yonkers.

The public benefit and objective of this contract is to restore tree plantings throughout the Bronx River Parkway Reservation, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
