SUBJECT: Request Authority to Obtain a Proposal and Negotiate a Fee with Maser Consulting PA,
in connection with Engineering Services for the Rehabilitation of Halstead Avenue Bridge over
Mamaroneck River (BIN 3348290), Village of Mamaroneck, New York (#14-906)

Authority of your Honorable Board is requested to obtain a proposal to negotiate a fee in connection with engineering services for the Rehabilitation of Halstead Avenue Bridge over Mamaroneck River (BIN 3348290), Village of Mamaroneck, New York.

The objective of this project will be to rehabilitate the Halstead Avenue Bridge over Mamaroneck River (BIN 3348290). This work is necessary due to extensive deterioration of the bridge. The existing bridge was built in 1910 and has an annual average daily traffic count ("AADT") of 3,212. It is a single span steel beam plate girder bridge approximately 48 feet long by 68 feet wide. This bridge has a condition rating of 4.833 and requires rehabilitation to insure that it can remain a key component of the County's infrastructure, vital to the Village of Mamaroneck. This rating system, using a scale of 1 ("hazardous") through 7 ("new"), is a weighted average of the condition of an evaluated bridge. A rating below 5 indicates that a bridge requires work and delay of this work shall result in the continued deterioration of the bridge. This project will implement the most cost-effective and environmentally compliant technologies available. This agreement will benefit the public as it will enhance the functionality of the bridge structure ensuring its safe use by the public, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area of Safety and Security.

On October 24, 2013, the Professional Prequalification Board was canvassed for the purpose of generating a list of qualified firms to provide professional services for this project. The Professional Prequalification Board approved a list of eight (8) qualified firms to provide professional services for this project. As the fee is estimated to be less than \$100,000, on November 26, 2013 the Professional Selection Board reviewed this eligible list of qualified firms and selected the best three qualified firms to possibly perform said services. The three firms were:

After careful consideration, the Professional Selection Board ranked the firm of Maser Consulting PA as the number one firm suitable for this proposal for these professional services. Authorization to enter into an Agreement will be submitted to your Honorable Board when negotiations are satisfactorily completed. This selection process followed the requirements as outlined in the Rules of the Professional Prequalification and Selection Boards and the Laws of Westchester County.

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This matter has been reviewed by the Deputy County Executive and the Commissioner of the Department of Planning, and they are in concurrence.

I recommend adoption of the attached proposed Resolution.
