The requested grant amendments are required as a result of the passage of the Homeless Emergency Assistance and Rapid Transition to Housing ("HEARTH") Act of 2009 which amended the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 USC 11302 et seq). All other terms and conditions of the Grant Agreements shall remain in full force and effect.

The proposed agreements will serve **a public purpose** by providing the funds necessary for the County to pay for Continuum of Care programs designed to provide transitional and permanent housing to DSS's homeless clients.

The goals and objectives of the proposed Grant Amendment Agreements are to enable the County to continue its Continuum of Care program.

The goals and objectives of the proposed amendment agreements are in the best interests of the County in terms of fiscal responsibility, as the proposed grant amendment agreements will make available to the County the funds necessary to implement the aforementioned program. The goals and objectives of the proposed agreements are also in the best interests of the County in terms of both fiscal responsibility and public health and safety as the programs funded by the proposed agreement will be aimed at ensuring the well being and safety of the targeted population and addressing the issues of homelessness and welfare dependency in the County which can reduce the costs associated with social services provided by the County.
