RE: Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to amend a grant agreement with the State of New York to accept funding to improve access to polling places, in order to extend the term of the agreement

Pursuant to a Resolution approved by your Honorable Board on January 18, 2007, the County of Westchester entered into a grant agreement with the State of New York to accept New York State Voting Access for Individuals with Disabilities funding in the amount of \$265,055 payable on a reimbursement basis, for a term commencing April 1, 2006 and terminating March 31, 2008, with the State's option to extend the contract for one additional year.

On June 12, 2008, your Honorable Board authorized a one-year extension to the agreement for the period April 1, 2008 through March 31, 2009. On April 6, 2009 your Honorable Board authorized a second one-year extension to the agreement for the period April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010. On February 18, 2010 your Honorable Board authorized a third one-year extension to the agreement for the period April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011. On May 19, 2011 your Honorable Board authorized a fourth one-year extension to the agreement for the April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013 term. On May 12, 2013 your Honorable Board authorized a fifth one-year extension to the agreement for the April 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014 term. All five extensions were subsequently executed.

The State and the County now wish to further extend the term of the agreement for the period April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015 so that unexpended grant funds may be utilized. All other terms and conditions of the agreement will remain unchanged.

The public purpose of this amendment is to facilitate the purchase of necessary equipment and to make physical improvements to ensure that voters with disabilities have access to all poll sites across Westchester County. Utilizing grant funding will alleviate the need for the use of County tax dollars for this purpose.

In order to take advantage of these grant funds your approval of the annexed proposed resolution is requested.
