The 2014 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to replace four existing rooftop HVAC units which have failed. The project includes all required appurtenances, rigging, controls, structural work, startup, and testing. The rooftop HVAC units will be purchased and delivered to the site via a County issued purchase order.

The objective of this contract is to maintain heating and air conditioning equipment for continuous and uninterrupted operation.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by allowing the Public Safety Academy to remain operational.

The project will provide energy savings by utilizing high efficiency gas fired HVAC units, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Chapter 308 of the Laws of the County of Westchester, the policy of the County is to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
