The 2014 Capital Account contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to remove existing invasive plant species through methods of herbicide applications along with clearing and grubbing. The project will include the planting of native plant species and seed mixes appropriate to wetland and floodplain areas.

The objective of this contract is to stabilize the streambank on the Mamaroneck River, using bioengineering techniques along with restoration of the existing freshwater wetland.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will provide the environmental benefits of reducing flooding and erosion along with creating an improved habitat for wildlife in Saxon Woods Park, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
