RE: Authority to amend an agreement with the State University of New York, acting by and through Purchase College, whereby the County will provide access to a system called the Westchester County Repository for Integrated Criminalistic Information (the "RICI System") to allow for the electronic transmission and storage of criminal record and police blotter information in order to extend the term

By resolution approved on November 24, 2009 (the "November Resolution"), your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into a perpetual agreement (the "Agreement") with the State University of New York, acting by and through Purchase College, whereby the County would provide access to a system called the Westchester County Repository for Integrated Criminalistic Information (the "RICI System") to allow for the electronic transmission and storage of criminal record and police blotter information. The Agreement was subsequently executed however it contained a termination date of November 30, 2014.

Accordingly, authority is respectfully requested for the County to amend the Agreement in order to extend the term so that it will continue in perpetuity as originally authorized by your Honorable Board in the November Resolution.

Except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. Either party may cancel the Agreement on thirty (30) days written notice to the other.

The goals and objectives of the proposed agreement are to provide local law enforcement agencies investigating crimes and other violations with a vast quantity of data from different sources using information technology. This program will support the public health, safety and/or welfare by insuring that investigators are provided with reliable criminalistics information as soon as possible. RICI acts like a central booking system to make arrest processing faster and decreases time waiting for criminal history responses from the state and federal databases. The goals and objectives of this program will be tracked and monitored by the Department of Public

Safety who will track participation by local departments in the program as well as our own usage in the form of arrests, bookings or incarcerations, to monitor the success and/or failure of this program.

Accordingly, we most respectfully recommend approval of the attached Resolution.
