The 2014 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of all labor, material and equipment required to replace the Hawthorne Receiving Manhole and make miscellaneous site improvements including construction of a reinforced concrete vehicle wash-down pad along with resurfacing of the asphalt driveway.

The objective of this contract is to allow the Department of Environmental Facilities to maintain sanitary collection systems and to ensure continuous and reliable processing of wastewater.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring continued uninterrupted operation of the pump station's wastewater treatment systems. This project will enable the Department of Environmental Facilities to carry out its basic mission to provide wastewater treatment and maintain satisfactory water quality, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
