On December 15, 2011 your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester ("County") to enter into an agreement with POMCO for the provision of health plan administrative services and Preferred Provider Organization Network Services in connection with the County's Employee and Retiree Benefit Plans ("Agreement") for a three (3) year term which is expiring December 31, 2014. The resolution also provided the County with the sole option to extend the about February 8, 2012. agreement for two (2) additional two (2) year terms. The Agreement was duly executed on or

The attached Resolution, if approved by your Honorable Board, will authorize the County to exercise the first of its two renewal options with POMCO on the same terms and conditions, for a term commencing January 1, 2015 and expiring December 31, 2016, in an amount not-toexceed \$4,448,450 per year, which will increase the total contract amount not-to-exceed from \$13,467,798 to \$22,364,698.

This administrative fee is based on the pricing proposed and the number of eligible employees and retirees (the "census") provided by the County. These amounts may fluctuate based on the monthly census; however, the price proposal will remain the same over the two year term of the agreement. If there is an increase or decrease in the yearly amounts indicated above, the change will be due to fluctuations in the census.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, as amended, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Based upon the foregoing, I recommend approval of the attached resolution authorizing the County to exercise its first renewal option to extend the Agreement with POMCO for the provision of health plan administrative services in connection with the County's Employee and

RESOLVED, that all other terms and conditions of the original agreement shall remain the same; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute and deliver any and all documents and to take all action necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
