On October 15, 2014, four (4) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 14-534 for Milling and Resurfacing, Various County Roadways, Cities of Yonkers and White Plains, Towns of Mount Pleasant and Eastchester, and Villages of Scarsdale, Tuckahoe and Bronxville, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that PCI Industries Corp. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$1,119,815.00, and has proposed the utilization of the following subcontractors: Verde Electric Maintenance Corp. (Traffic Signal Work), 89 Edison Avenue, Mount Vernon, New York 10550; and Safety Marking Inc. (Pavement Markings), 255 Hancock Avenue, Bridgeport, Connecticut 06605.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that PCI Industries Corp.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to replace substandard areas of asphalt paving, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that various County roadways in the Cities of Yonkers and White Plains, Towns of Mount Pleasant and Eastchester, and Villages of Scarsdale, Tuckahoe and Bronxville meet current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 14-534 be awarded to PCI Industries Corp. in the amount of \$1,119,815.00.
