On October 15, 2014, four (4) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 14-504 for Hurricane Sandy Rehabilitation, Effluent Pump Building Roof Replacement, Mamaroneck Wastewater Treatment Plant, Mamaroneck, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Posylio GC Corp. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$95,340.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Posylio GC Corp.:
