RE: Authority to enter into an agreement with the United States of America, acting by and through its Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration, pursuant to which the County, acting by and through its Department of Public Safety, will participate in the Westchester County Drug Enforcement Task Force for the period commencing September 30, 2014 and continuing through September 29, 2015 for an amount not-to-exceed \$52,123.

Authority is sought for the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Public Safety (the "Department"), to enter into an agreement with the United States of America, acting by and through its Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA"), pursuant to which the County will participate in the Westchester County Drug Enforcement Task Force ("Task Force") for a term commencing September 30, 2014, and terminating on September 29, 2015 (the "Agreement").

Pursuant to the terms of the Agreement, the County will assign three (3) experienced officers to the Task Force. The Task Force will perform the following activities and duties: disrupting illicit drug traffic in Westchester County by immobilizing targeted violators and trafficking organizations; gathering and reporting intelligence data relating to trafficking in narcotics and dangerous drugs; and conducting undercover operations, where appropriate and engaging in other traditional methods of investigation in order that the Task Force's activities will result in effective prosecution before the courts of the United States and the State of New York.

In consideration for services rendered, the DEA will, subject to the availability of funds, reimburse the County an amount not-to-exceed \$52,123 for overtime payments made by it to Department officers assigned to the Task Force. However, the Department will remain responsible for establishing the salary and benefits of Department officers assigned to the Task Force and for making all payments due them.

Assets seized during investigations will be forfeited and shared in accordance with the Attorney General's Guidelines on Seized and Forfeited Property.

The public purpose of this Agreement is to disrupt the illicit drug traffic in the Westchester area.

The goals and objectives of this program are to investigate and prosecute illicit drug trafficking in Westchester County.

The goals and objectives of this program will support the public health, safety and/or welfare by removing large quantities of drugs destined for the streets of Westchester. By collaborating enforcement activities of County and local law enforcement agencies, they will be more able to thwart illegal drug activity that has a substantial and detrimental effect to the health and welfare of the people in Westchester County and its surrounding areas.

The goals and objectives of this program will be tracked and monitored by the Task Force Policy Board and the participating police agencies. All officers assigned to the Task Force shall adhere to DEA policies, procedures and guidelines including conduct, property, reporting systems, evidence handling and use of firearms. The WCTF shall maintain all such reports and records for audit and examination.

I certify that my department, a) has copies of, or access to, all applicable laws, rules, regulations, grant applications, and grant agreements (including any master grant agreement), as well as any guidance or instructions received from the agency making the grant (the "Grant Terms"), b) has reviewed the Grant Terms, c) is aware of and understands all of the Grant Terms, and d) can and will comply with all of the Grant Terms.

As the County is not procuring goods or services, the requirements of the Westchester County Procurement Policy do not apply

Wherefore, authority is respectfully sought for the County of Westchester to enter into this agreement.
