The 2015 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for installation of GPS equipment at each intersection along the corridor, installation of traffic signal equipment and controller modifications for queue jump lanes along with implementation and programming of new signal timings.

The objective of this contract is to improve traffic signal equipment and safety conditions along County roads.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that Central Park Avenue (Route 100) meets current codes and standards, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Payment for this entire contract will be made from New York State Multi-Modal Funds and New York State Dedicated Funds, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
