SUBJECT: Authority to, exercise the County's option to extend the term of an agreement with R&S Waste Services, LLC for one two (2) year option period, thereby increasing the amount of the agreement by \$776,640.00 and extending the term of the agreement through February 28, 2017. (Contract No. 12-201)

By Resolution approved on March 1, 2012 (the "March 1st Resolution"), your Honorable Board awarded Contract No. 12-201 to R&S Waste Services, LLC ("R&S Waste"). The March 1st Resolution authorized the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into Contract No. 12-201 with R&S Waste, pursuant to which R&S Waste was to provide Countywide Solid Waste Removal Services for Westchester County, New York, for the amount of \$1,164,960.00 for the period March 1, 2012 through February 28, 2015, ("Contract No. 12-201" or the "Agreement"), with the County having the sole option to extend the Agreement for one (1) two (2) year option period.

The County now seeks authority from your Honorable Board to exercise the two (2) year renewal option, and thereby, 1) increasing the amount of the Agreement by \$776,640.00 from an amount of \$1,164,960.00 to a new amount of \$1,941,600.00, and 2) extending the termination date of the Agreement from February 28, 2015 to February 28, 2017.

All other terms and conditions of the March 1, 2012 Resolution and the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and unchanged.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by maintaining clean and sanitary conditions, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

RESOLUTION

CONTRACT NO. 12-201

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and Transportation, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County is authorized to exercise its two (2) year renewal option for Contract 12-201 with R&S Waste Services, LLC, 500 Mamaroneck Avenue, Harrison, New York 10528 for Countywide Solid Waste Removal Services, Westchester County, New York, and thereby, a) increasing the amount of the Agreement by \$776,640.00, from \$1,164,960.00 to \$1,941,600.00, and b) extending the termination date of the Agreement from February 28, 2015 to February 28, 2017; and be it further

RESOLVED, that except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions of the March 1, 2012 Resolution and the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and unchanged; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to effectuate the purpose hereof.
