On February 11, 2015, one (1) bid was received and opened for Contract No. 13-534 for Hurricane Sandy Rehabilitation – Phase I, Below-Grade Unit Process Power, Instrumentation and Controls Replacement, Yonkers Joint Wastewater Treatment Plant, Yonkers, New York.

The bid exceeded the amount budgeted for this project. The department is reviewing the contract documents to reduce the overall scope of work in order to reduce costs.

Therefore, it is requested that the bid be rejected and re-advertised as Contract No. 13-534-Rev.

The objective of this contract is to allow the Department of Environmental Facilities to maintain its treatment plant systems and to ensure continuous and reliable processing of wastewater.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring continued uninterrupted operation of the plant's wastewater treatment systems. This project will enable the Department of Environmental Facilities to carry out its basic mission to provide wastewater treatment and maintain satisfactory water quality, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
