RE: **Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to enter into an Agreement with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services in an amount not to Exceed \$31,849.00 in order to accept Federal funding to implement and operate the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) - Juvenile Community Service Program from July 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015, pursuant to an approved budget**

Authority is sought for the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services in an amount not to exceed \$31,849.00 in order to accept Federal funds to operate the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) - Juvenile Community Service Program from July 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015, pursuant to an approved budget.

The proposed agreement will enable the Westchester County Department of Probation (the "Department") to continue to provide targeted interventions for youth in the community who present the highest risk and potential for residential placement. As part of our ongoing effort to reduce residential placements of juveniles, the Westchester County Department of Probation will attempt to enhance our community supervision model by conducting Juvenile Community Service. The grant will fund two (2) Department of Probation Officers in each of the three (3) district offices so that the Officers can supervise the juveniles performing community service on Saturdays to ensure that the community service will not interfere with the juveniles' education.

These performance measures were/will be tracked by Department employees by the submission of mandated reports designed by the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services on a quarterly basis.

Fiscal Responsibility – This program is primarily funded through the Federal government, offsetting tax levy.

This agreement is exempt under the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3 (a)iii thereof which exempts transactions or contracts with any political subdivision including New York State.
