SUBJECT: Authority to amend an agreement with The Women's Enterprise Development Center, Inc. to provide microenterprise training and assistance to poor and minority women by increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$22,448

On March 28, 2013, your Honorable Board approved a resolution authorizing the County of Westchester, acting by and through its Office for Women, (the "County") to enter into an agreement with The Women's Enterprise Development Center, Inc. (the "Center"), pursuant to which the Center would provide microenterprise training and assistance to poor and minority women to assist them in reaching economic self-sufficiency, for a term commencing January 1, 2013 and continuing through December 31, 2015, for an amount not-to-exceed \$179,370 (the "Agreement"). The Agreement was subsequently executed.

On May 8, 2014, your Honorable Board approved a resolution authorizing the County to amend the Agreement by increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$21,794, from an amount not-to-exceed \$179,370 to an amount not-to-exceed \$201,164, pursuant to an approved budget (the "First Amendment"). The First Amendment was subsequently executed.

Authority is now respectfully requested from your Honorable Board for the County to further amend the Agreement by increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$22,448, from an amount not-to-exceed \$201,164 to an amount not-to-exceed \$223,612 (the "Second Amendment"). This additional funding will only be applied to the 2015 budget within the Agreement.

Except as specifically amended hereby, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain the same.

The proposed Second Amendment will serve a public purpose by providing additional funding for the Center to provide more women with the training necessary to become economically self-sufficient. The skills learned by participants enable them to depend less on government entitlements or not at all. Some graduates augment their low incomes with entrepreneurship, while others are able to support themselves entirely. Some even hire staff, creating new avenues for employment for Westchester residents.

The goal and objective of the proposed Second Amendment is to provide additional funding for the Center to provide microenterprise training and assistance to poor and minority women.

The goal and objective of the proposed Second Amendment will be tracked and monitored by the Office for Women.

Attached for your consideration is a proposed Resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the County Executive, the Chairman of the Westchester County Board of Legislators, and the Director of the Office for Women be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester, acting by and through its Office for Women, (the "County") is hereby authorized to amend an agreement with The Women's Enterprise Development Center, Inc. (the "Center"), pursuant to which the Center will provide microenterprise training and assistance to poor and minority women to assist them in reaching economic self-sufficiency, for a term commencing January 1, 2013 and continuing through December 31, 2015, for an amount not-to-exceed exceed \$201,164 (the "Agreement"), in order to increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$22,448, from an amount not-to-exceed \$201,164 to an amount not-to-exceed \$223,612; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this additional funding will only be applied to the 2015 budget within the Agreement; and be it further

RESOLVED, that except as specifically amended hereby, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain the same; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee be and hereby is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents and take any actions necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
