On September 9, 2015, nine (9) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 09-547 for PIN 8760.92 Rehabilitation of the Ashford Avenue Bridge (BIN 5348380) and Ramp (BIN 534838A), Villages of Ardsley and Dobbs Ferry, New York, Federal Aid Project.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that E.E. Cruz & Company, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$17,902,768.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that E.E. Cruz & Company, Inc.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to repair substandard structural elements of the Ashford Avenue Bridge, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the Ashford Avenue Bridge meets current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Payment for a portion of this contract will be made from the Federal National Highway Performance Program and the New York State Marchiselli Program, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 09-547 be awarded to E.E. Cruz & Company, Inc. in the amount of \$17,902,768.00.
