The 2015 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to replace and upgrade process equipment associated with the primary, secondary, heating and chemical handling areas at the Mamaroneck Wastewater Treatment Plant. Work will include upgrading of primary and final effluent pumps, valves, piping, instrumentation and control panels, as well as replacement of chemical tanks and plant heating boilers along with all associated piping, valves and controls.

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this contract is to replace and upgrade the primary and secondary process equipment that has reached the end of its useful life to ensure process reliability and environmentally compliant operation of the treatment plant.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will ensure that the plant's operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
