The 2015 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to permanently divert flow from a sanitary sewer located beneath the floor of the Playland Park Bathhouse to a new sanitary sewer to be constructed through Westchester County property in the Rye Playland parking lot and along Rye Beach Avenue.

The objective of this contract is to mitigate the risk of building issues within the Bathhouse by removing from service the sanitary sewer and to facilitate easier access for maintenance, inspection and repairs for the new sanitary sewer.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will remove from service an existing sanitary sewer located under the floor of the Playland Park Bathhouse and it will ensure that the operation of the new relocated sanitary sewer is safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County. The existing location of the sanitary sewer below the Bathhouse floor makes the sewer difficult to access for maintenance and repair.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
