The 2015 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to construct a new access driveway off of Jackson Avenue for County maintenance personnel to access the Sprain Lift Pumping Station located between the northbound and southbound lanes of the Sprain Brook Parkway in the Town of Greenburgh.

The objective of this contract is to provide life-safety site improvements at the Sprain Lift Pumping Station by providing an access driveway to the Sprain Lift Pumping Station off Jackson Avenue, instead of from the left lane of the northbound Sprain Brook Parkway. Present ingress and egress for vehicles is very dangerous off the Sprain Brook Parkway and the new driveway will provide safety for the traveling public, as well as County maintenance personnel.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will allow for safe access to the Sprain Lift Pumping Station for County maintenance personnel to perform required maintenance, inspection and repairs to ensure that the operation of the Sprain Lift Pumping Station is safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
