RE: Request for authority for the County of Westchester to amend its

Agreement with the Westchester Public/Private Membership Fund for Aging Services, Inc. in order to exercise the second of its five options to

renew the Agreement to provide Livable Communities Volunteer

Coordination services, for the program period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016 for an amount not-to-exceed \$203,000 in County tax

dollars, subject to an approved budget

By resolution approved on March 20, 2014 (the "March 20th Resolution") your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Senior Programs and Services (the "Department"), to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement") with the Westchester Public/Private Membership Fund for Aging Services, Inc. (the "Contractor"), pursuant to which the Contractor would provide wable Communities Volunteer Coordination services (the "Program"), for the program period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014, for an amount not to exceed \$151,000 in County tax dollars, to be paid pursuant to an approved budget, with the County having the sole option to renew the Agreement with the Contractor for up to five (5) additional one-year periods, subject to the prior approval of your Honorable Board. The Agreement was subsequently executed

Thereafter, by resolution approved on December 4, 2014 (the "December 4th Resolution") your Honorable Board authorized the County to amend the Agreement with the Contractor in order to increase the not to exceed amount thereunder by an additional \$22,000, thereby increasing the total amount authorized under the Agreement from \$151,000 to \$173,000 (the "First Amendment"). The First Amendment was subsequently executed.

Thereafter, by resolution approved on May 21, 2015 (the "May 21st Resolution") your Honorable Board authorized the County to amend the Agreement with the Contractor in order to exercise the first of its five options to renew the Agreement for the Program

period January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015, for an amount not to exceed \$173,000 in County tax dollars, to be paid pursuant to an approved budget (the "Second Amendment"). The Second Amendment was subsequently executed.

The County now seeks authority to further amend the Agreement with the Contractor in order to exercise the second of its five options to renew the Agreement to provide the Program services for the Program period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, for an amount not-to-exceed \$203,000 in County tax dollars, subject to an approved budget (the "Third Amendment").

It should be noted that the not-to-exceed amount for 2016 has increased by \$30,000. The additional funds will be used to expand the Civable Communities Chronic Disease Self-Management Program (CDSMP), designed for community settings such as senior centers, churches, libraries and hospitals for people with different chronic health problems. Six-week workshops build participant's confidence in their ability to manage their health conditions. The CDSMP program is evidence-based and has been proven to decrease participant's emergency room and hospital visits.

The proposed Agreement is exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a) xix thereof.

For the prior contract year, the Livable Communities Volunteer Coordination Services has achieved the following: Recruited an additional 18 villages comprised of approximately 10,000 volunteers; 92 educational sessions; 30 regional council meetings and contacts with approximately 30,149 seniors.

Except as specifically amended as described herein, all other terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Accordingly, I recommend adoption of the proposed resolution.

UPON A COMMUNICATION FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF THE WESTCHESTER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SENIOR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES, BE IT HEREBY:

RESOLVED,

that the County of Westchester (the "County") is hereby authorized to amend an agreement (the "Agreement") with the Westchester Public/Private Membership Fund for Aging Services, Inc. (the "Contractor"), as previously amended, in order to exercise the second of its five options to renew the Agreement with the Contractor, pursuant to which the Contractor shall provide Livable Communities Volunteer Coordination services (the "Program") for the Program period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, for an amount not-to-exceed \$203,000 in County tax dollars, subject to an approved budget; and be it further

that except as specifically amended hereby, all other terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect; and be it further

that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee be and hereby is authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
